This year's Vacation Bible School takes place in Nazareth, where Jesus grew up. The curriculum invites us to recreate our own Nazareth, complete with ancient buildings and local artisans, allowing kids to experience a glimpse of life in Jesus' time. This kind of village experience however, may take this community's many talents to recreate.

Here are some examples of the help we need but please contact us if you feel you can help in ANY way. Training and other help will of course be provided for everyone who is involved.

**Small Group Leaders:** Each leader will be responsible for taking a group of about 10 kids around to the different activities of the day. At least once during the day you will be asked to check in with your group with specific questions.

**Craft Leaders:** Crafts this year are a recreation of ancient artisan booths. We have a dye shop, a carpentry shop, an olive oil shop, and several more. This job may only require your help one day of the week-- where you would lead kids through a craft at your shop.

**Food Leader:** You would be responsible for organizing and preparing the snacks for each day.

**Drama:** You will lead, or help lead, the part of the program that tells a story from the bible about Jesus' life.

**Decorations:** We need a great deal of help in this area. We need to envision and then build a small Nazareth in the Hall.

**Games:** Lead small groups through pre-planned games and activities each day.
